Come join RMMI and with Tom Cuneio CAD Blox LLC for an Presentation on BIM-M. BIM is an acronym that stands for an object, a "building information model" and also a process for creating and using that object, "building information modeling". The BIM model provides a digital representation of the building, so that the modeling and analysis tools used by architects, engineers, constructors, managers and owners can read from and write to the same information source.

BIM is expanding quickly within the construction industry worldwide. However, the masonry industry is not well represented. Therefore, there is a need to develop BIM tools for masonry to maintain market share. With that intent, an Initiative was formed in 2012 specifically to advance BIM for masonry.

The Initiative BIM-M (Building Information Modeling for Masonry) includes many sponsors with an Executive Committee of its primary funding sponsors listed alphabetically:

The mission of the BIM-M Initiative is to unify the masonry industry and all supporting industries through encouraging the development and implementation of BIM for masonry software to facilitate smoother workflows and collaboration across all disciplines from owner, architect, engineer, manufacturer, mason, contractor, construction manager, and maintenance professionals.

After the BIM-M presentation our own executive director Bret Terry will be introducing our new 2018 Colorado Masonry Systems Guide. This guide will be a fundamental tool, resource, and design manual used to educate and promote masonry in the architectural and design communities throughout the Colorado Region. This guide will provide standardized systems guide of best practices for masonry wall design systems in construction, making it a primary information resource on masonry construction systems. It will also address the new challenges of energy code requirements for continuous insulation.

What Special Inspectors are Looking for on Your Jobs and Why

8:00 am- 12:00 pm

Special inspection is increasingly being required on structural masonry construction projects, and it will likely become commonplace in the coming years. This course is targeted towards key field personnel, architects, foreman, superintendents, estimators, project managers, and field techs for testing companies.

Topics covered include:

- *What is special inspection?*
- *Why is it important?*
- *When is it required?*
- *Why special inspection sometimes varies from job to job?*
- *Who is able to perform special inspections?*
- *What is to be inspected and how often?*
- *How to avoid conflicts with the Special Inspector?*

In addition, some key aspects of special inspection including placement of reinforcement, anchors and grout will be examined in more depth, so that everyone knows what is expected, why, and repercussions if not done properly. Issues inspectors may be looking for in regards to masonry materials, proper placement of materials, mixing and placement of mortar and grout, testing and appropriate severe weather procedures will also be reviewed.

The course will be presented by Phillip J. Samblanet, P.E., Executive Director of the Masonry Society, who serves on the International Code Council's (ICC) Structural Masonry Special Inspectors Examination Development Committee and who has written several articles on the topic and trained hundreds of special inspectors during his career.
