Michelle Mungall was the first woman elected as MLA for Nelson-Creston in 2009 and reelected in 2013 and 2017. In 2002, she was elected to Nelson City Council – the youngest person ever.

On January 22, 2020 she was appointed Minster of Jobs, Economic Development and Competitiveness. She previously held the position as Minister of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources.

Her university studies and her career in community development have led her to champion social justice and financial security. Prior to entering politics, she worked in the non-profit sector to reduce poverty and support people in crisis. Internationally, she worked at YMCA Zambia, helping to improve the lives of girls with HIV/AIDS and has volunteered as an election observer in two Ukraine elections.
